# **Club Success Tip for September**

Inquirers depend upon Internet search to find clubs to visit, and their effort is made easier when clubs ensure that their search results are up to date. One that's especially important to check and correct is the Find-a-Club page for each club at Toastmasters International. Here's an example: Check your club's information – is the location correct? Is the map correct? Are your meeting times accurate? Does this page correctly link to your club web site and the right email box? Club officers can bring this information up to date in Club Central.

# **Special Recognition**
