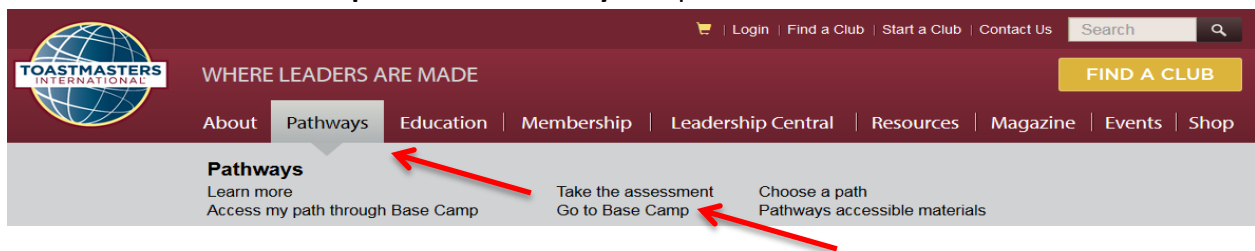

Getting Started in Pathways

Accessing Pathways

- If necessary, create a login and password at <https://www.toastmasters.org/>
- Select **Go to Base Camp** from the **Pathways** drop-down menu



Choose Your Path

- Click on **Continue to Path Selection** in the left-hand box



Welcome to Pathways screen

- Select ONE of the following two options:
 - Click on **Take Your Assessment** to select an on-line path (recommended)
 - Click on **Purchase Printed Materials** to buy printed manuals

Recommended

Base Camp \$20

Base Camp is your online gateway to Pathways. Embarking on your Pathways journey through Base Camp is recommended because it offers full access to the Pathways learning experience and includes:

- ▶ 10 paths in English and eight other languages*
- ▶ Customized path recommendation based on your Pathways Assessment results
- ▶ Engaging videos, interactive activities and quizzes
- ▶ A unique evaluation resource for each project that can be completed and stored electronically
- ▶ Opportunity to earn and give digital badges
- ▶ Ability to share feedback online

*If you plan to work in a path in any language other than English, it is highly recommended that you use Base Camp. This way, you can choose from all 10 paths as opposed to two.

Printed Materials \$45

Select paths are available in print. Although you will have the resources you need to complete your path, your experience and path options are limited when compared to Base Camp. Choosing printed materials offers only partial access to the Pathways learning experience and includes:

- ▶ Five paths in English
- ▶ Two paths available in eight languages
- ▶ A unique evaluation resource for each project
- ▶ Full-color, professionally bound materials
- ▶ Standard shipping (with applicable fees)

Note: You will not be able to take the Pathways Assessment or have access to your path online.

- The new-member fee you paid to join Toastmasters pays for your path, but the printed materials will still require an extra fee.
- Pathways will recommend three paths when you complete the assessment, but you may select any path.
- If you change your mind you may change paths once, for free, within 30 days of your initial purchase.

Access Your Path

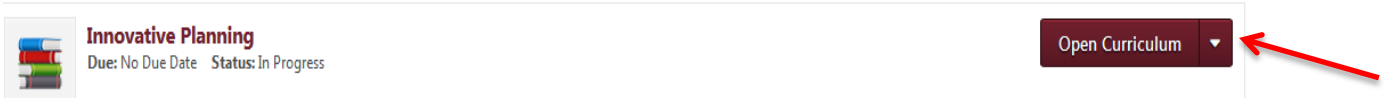
- Click on **Log in as a Member** in the **Welcome to Pathways** screen (above)



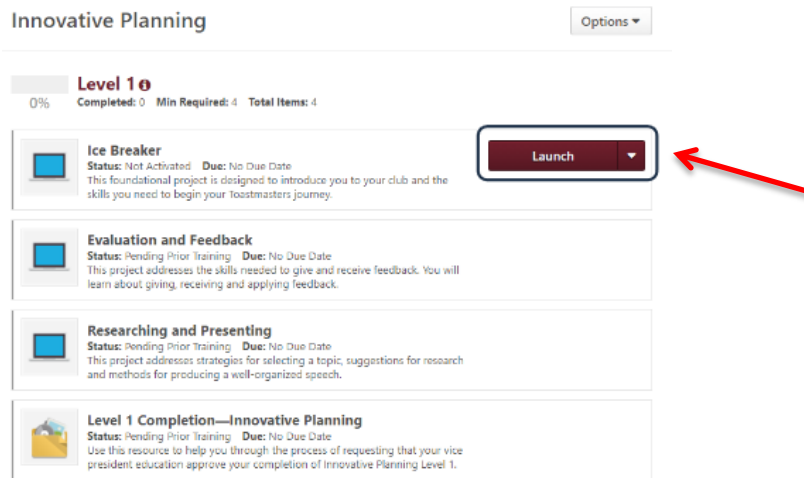
- Click on **Navigating Base Camp** to access videos explaining how to accomplish various tasks in Pathways.
- Click on **Speech Evaluations** to access evaluation forms for various projects. These forms are also available inside each project.
- Click on **My Education Transcript** to access the path you just selected.

Launch Your First Project - The Ice Breaker

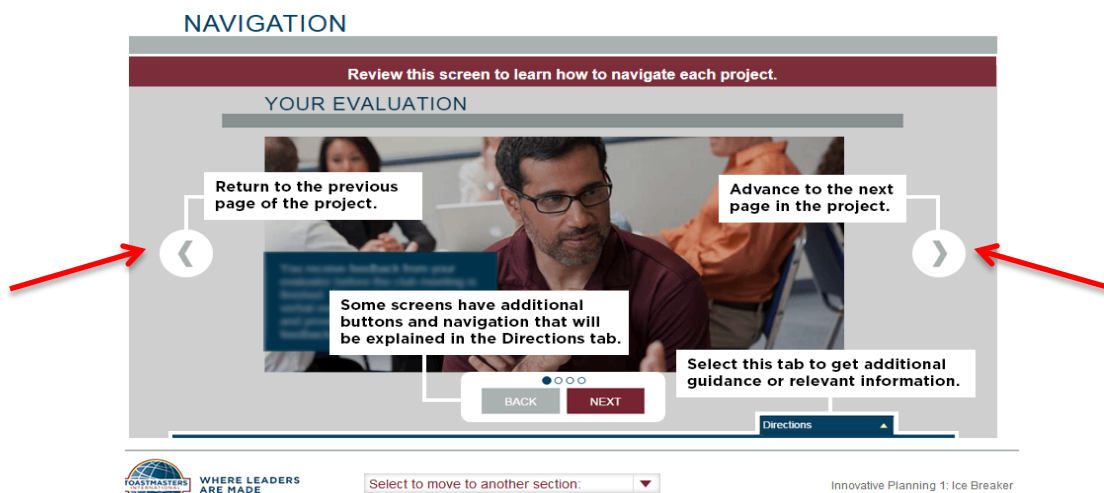
- Click on the **Open Curriculum** button for your path from your transcript.



- Click on the **Activate** button to enable the Ice Breaker project, then on the **Launch** button to open it in a new window.

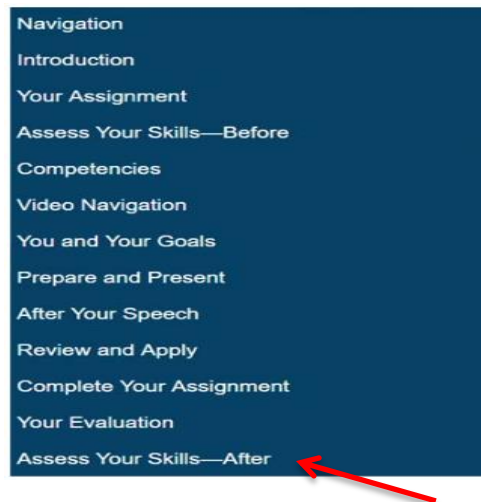


- The window will need to be resized to display the 'forward' and 'reverse' navigation arrows on the left and right sides of the slides.



Complete Your Ice Breaker

- Open the **Select to move to another section** drop-down at the bottom of the project, then select **Assess Your Skills - After**.



- Complete the assessment, then click on **Submit** to mark the Ice Breaker project complete and activate the other Level 1 projects. You will probably need to scroll down in the results comparison window to see this button.
- Note: Do not do this step until after you've presented your speech and received your evaluation.
