3. New Incentives and Awards (see Incentives page for detail)

a. Triple Crown (revised)

Description

Toastmasters can earn the Triple Crown Award from Pathways, Legacy, or Combination of Pathways and Legacy Education Programs from 1 July 2019 – 30 June 2020.

*Note: 2 Pathways levels = 1 Legacy award Pathways: Six (6) levels = D37 Triple Crown

<u>Legacy</u>: Any 3 Legacy education awards = D37 Triple Crown Or Combination of Pathways and Legacy Education Programs:

Example 1: Advanced Communicator Silver and 4 Pathways levels = D37 Triple Crown Example 2: Competent Leader, Advanced Leader Silver, and 2 Pathways levels = D37 Triple

Crown

b. Growth Incentive:

Based on the Club's Membership as of 1 July 2019, have a Net Growth of +5 members by 9/30/2019, Club will receive \$50 Gift Certificate.

If Net Growth of +5 members or more is maintained through 3/31/2020, Club will receive an additional \$50 Gift Certificate.

c. The Smedley Plus:

If five new members pay prorated fee plus the next six months, Club will receive Toastmasters International \$50 Gift Certificate.

d. Strength in Numbers Incentive

Requirements:

- A Your Club must have meet your 'Required Membership Strength' by June 30, 2019.
- B Your Club must have attained Distinguished status by June 30, 2019.
- C Your Club must have 5 Club Officers trained at an official Toastmasters Leadership Institute (TLI) training as posted on the District 37 calendar by August 31, 2019. Incentive:

Club will receive the Club Officer Pin Set, Item # 5801Z, valued at \$60.00.

Pathways Orientation Program

To help VPEs provide a positive initial experience to your new Toastmasters, District 37 under Rich Lemert and his team has developed a model Pathways Orientation program to use in your club. You can use it in conjunction with your existing orientation process to introduce new members to Pathways and guide them through their first project - the Ice Breaker. Meetup Access for Clubs

District 37 now offers a <u>free</u> Meetup Access Program allowing clubs to post events to a shared Meetup group page centered in their nearest metropolitan area. We created seven regional hubs to serve clubs across North Carolina. This saves clubs about \$200 per year in subscription fees. Meetups have proven invaluable in getting the word out about Toastmasters and attracting visitors. <u>Read more information and find instructions to set up your club.</u>

District Reformation

We've also added a page with information about <u>District Reformation</u> in 2020 (that is, the subdivision of District 37 into two separate Districts.) District 37, after July 1, 2020, will cover all clubs west of the north-south line that is the border between Guilford (Greensboro) and Alamance (Burlington) counties. The new District 117 will cover all clubs to the east of that line.
