I wanted to make sure a guest had a nametag, agenda, and was seated near an experienced member. It was a priority for me to bring enthusiasm from the minute they walked through that door. Although it has been a couple of terms since I was Club President, I still do it. Every meeting! As a leader, setting the level of expectation for how to interact with members and guests should be on your priority list. This is one of those things you can only show - telling doesn't work.

At your next meeting, just sit and watch the door. Does every member and guests get this type of treatment? If yes, good for you. You likely have a successful club. If no, ask yourself why it is not happening. Take action right away to raise the level of expectation to insure everyone gets recognition like this. If you do this, they will be calling you the Mayor in no time at all!
