

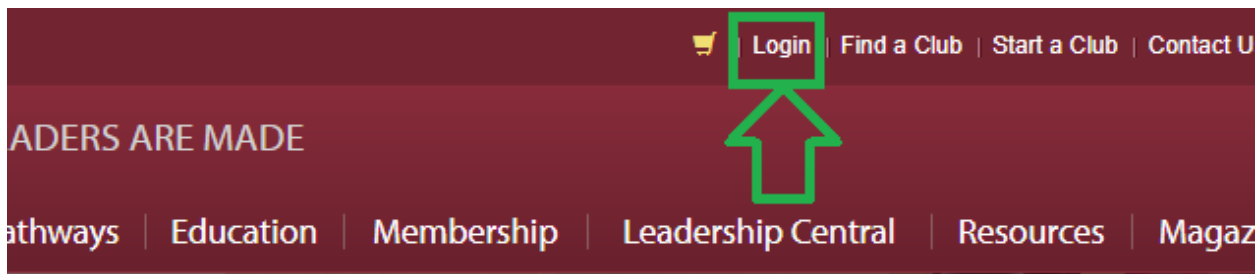
PATHWAYS NEW MEMBER GUIDE

Are you very excited about the Pathways Learning Experience? This guide walks you through the steps to get started on the new Pathways education program.

Step 1: Login to Toastmasters website:

Pathways was rolled out to our District 37 on October 31, 2017.

If you have never logged in, to get ready for Pathways, go to the Toastmasters Homepage (<https://www.toastmasters.org/>) and click on login at the top of the page.

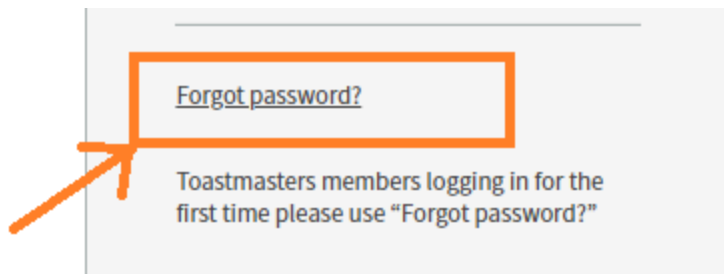


Step 2:

Enter your credentials (if you have logged in to the Toastmasters website in the past) and be logged in. You will be automatically redirected to the Toastmasters homepage.

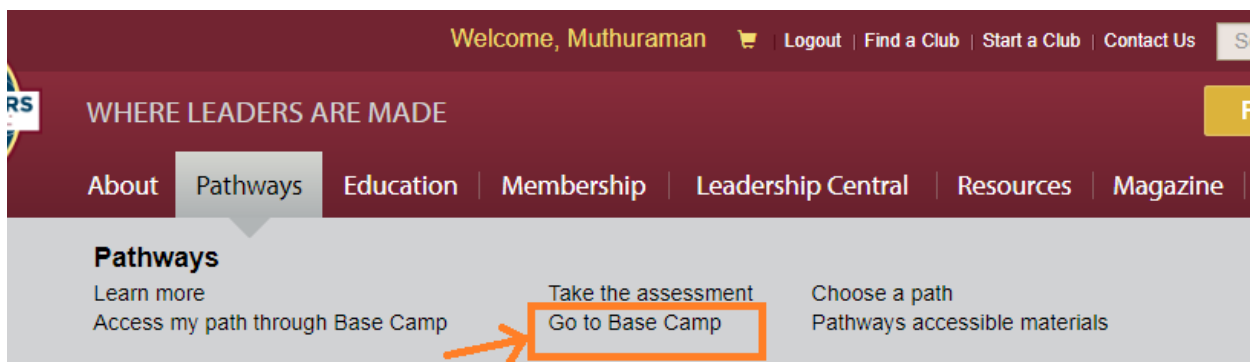

Step 3:

On the Toastmasters homepage ((<https://www.toastmasters.org/>)) click on the 'Pathways' tab. From here click on the 'Go to Base Camp' option.

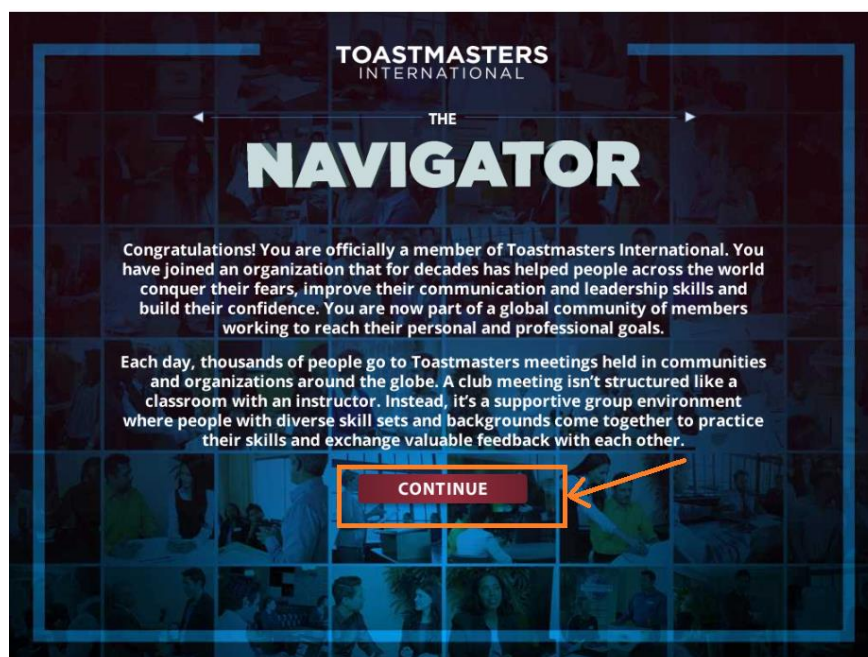

Step 5:

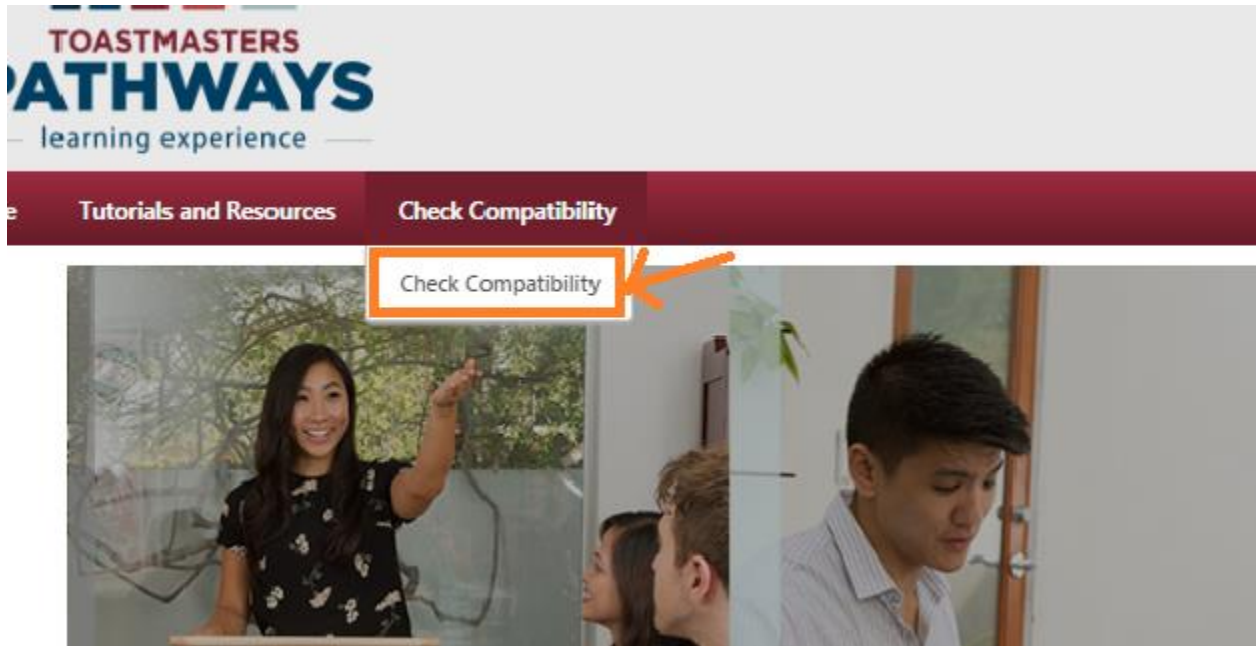
System Requirements

Step 6:

Once you are on Base Camp, you must disable the pop-up blocker on your browser in order to see your online projects and resources.

Hover your mouse pointer over ‘Check Compatibility’ tab. You will see a ‘Check Compatibility’ drop down option. Click on it.

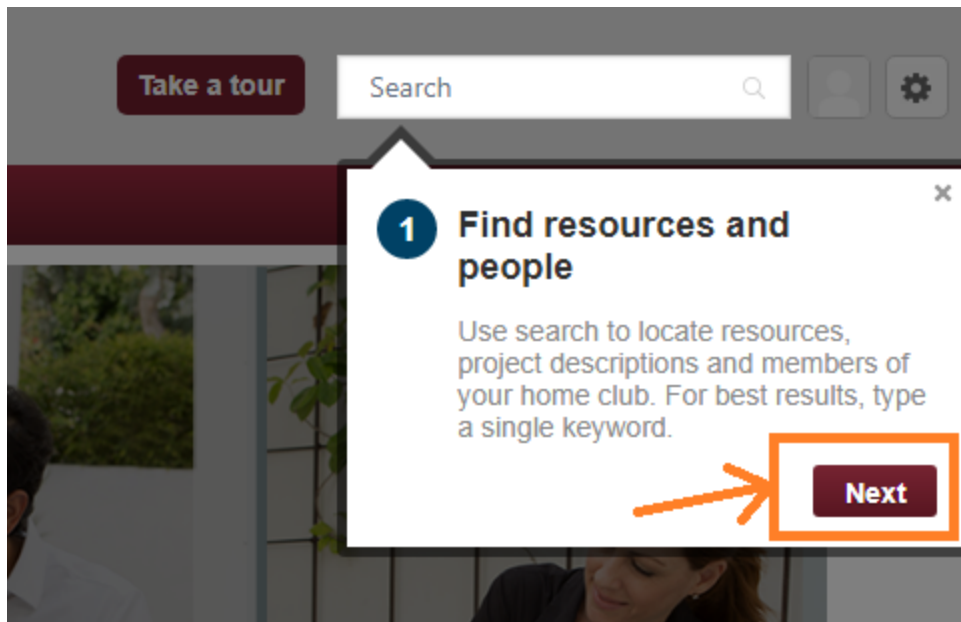


Base Camp actually has a feature to check the compatibility of your browser, then tells you how to alter your settings for an optimal experience. You can also manually change your pop-up blocker settings for your browser. If you don't know how to do this, simply look for help on the internet.

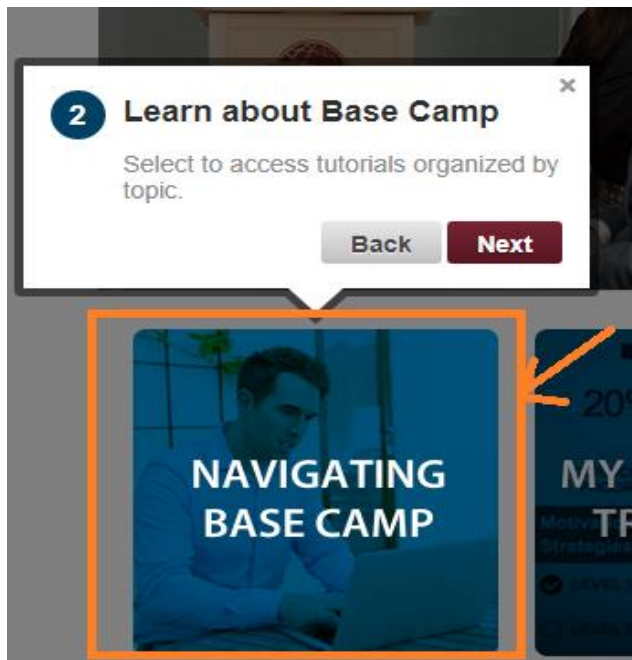
Step 7:

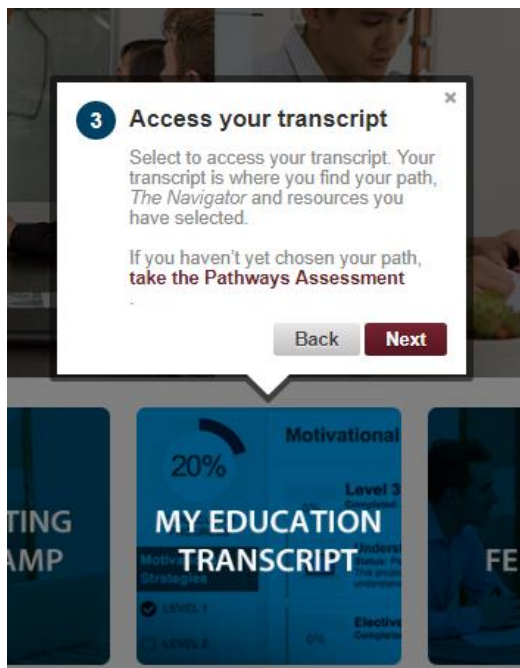
It is going to take you some time to watch through these videos. But if you do these your Pathways Experience will be terrific!

Click on 'Take a tour' to continue back on your tour to Item 3.



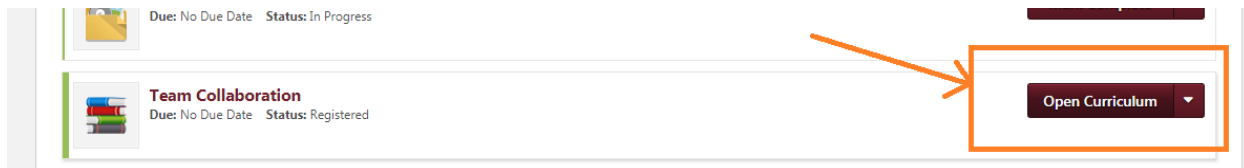
Read through this item and click 'Next'. Similarly, read through Item 4, 5, 6 and 7. Once completed, you have a solid understanding of basics in the Pathways program.
