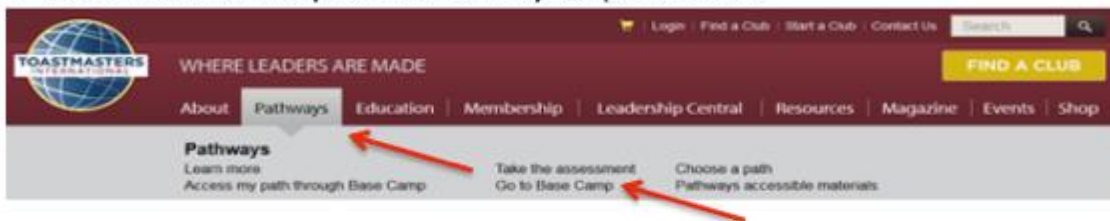

## Accessing Pathways

- Select **Go to Base Camp** from the **Pathways** drop-down menu

## Base Camp \$20

Base Camp is your online gateway to Pathways. Embarking on your Pathways journey through Base Camp is recommended because it offers full access to the Pathways learning experience and includes:

- ▶ 10 paths in English and eight other languages\*
- ▶ Customized path recommendation based on your Pathways Assessment results
- ▶ Engaging videos, interactive activities and quizzes
- ▶ A unique evaluation resource for each project that can be completed and stored electronically
- ▶ Opportunity to earn and give digital badges
- ▶ Ability to share feedback online

\*If you plan to work in a path in any language other than English, it is highly recommended that you use Base Camp. This way you can choose from all 10 paths as opposed to two.

## Printed Materials \$45

Select paths are available in print. Although you will have the resources you need to complete your path, your experience and path options are limited when compared to Base Camp. Choosing printed materials offers only partial access to the Pathways learning experience and includes:

- ▶ Five paths in English
- ▶ Two paths available in eight languages
- ▶ A unique evaluation resource for each project
- ▶ Full-color, professionally bound materials
- ▶ Standard shipping (with applicable fees)

Note: You will not be able to take the Pathways Assessment or have access to your path online.

- The new-member fee you paid to join Toastmasters pays for your path, but the printed materials will still require an extra fee.
- Pathways will recommend three paths when you complete the assessment, but you may select any path.
- If you change your mind you may change paths once, for free, within 30 days of your initial purchase.

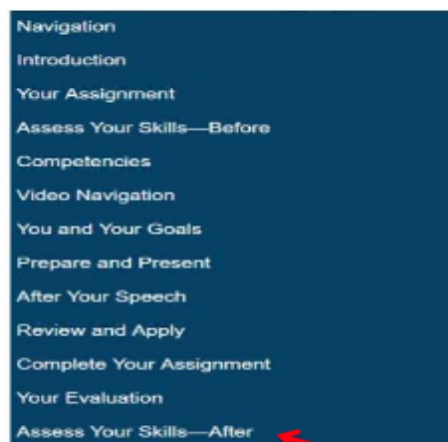
Launch

- Complete the assessment, then click on **Submit** to mark the Ice Breaker project complete and activate the other Level 1 projects. You will probably need to scroll down in the results comparison window to see this button.
- Note: Do not do this step until after you’ve presented your speech and received your evaluation.
